Dallas Area Chamber of Commerce Public Policy Committee Meeting Dallas School District Office Board Room Minutes from Thursday February 1, 2018

- 1. Voting members Present: Paul Trahan, Lavonne Wilson, Nancie Rogers Mike Barker.
- 2. Meeting called to order at 12:05 PM by Chairman Gene Henshaw.
- 3. Guest Speakers were: Greg Hansen, Polk County Administrator, Greg Ellis Interim Dallas City Manager, and Scott Whyte, Dallas City Planner.
- 4. Mr. Hansen expressed concern over HB4086 which would require counties to establish "in house" building inspectors rather than out sourcing which is what Polk County currently does. As always PERS issues need to be addressed. A bond issue for 9.7 million for county facilities will be on the May 15th ballot which would result in a property tax increase of about 11 cents per thousand.
- 5. Greg Ellis reported that the Legislature may require that the transit and lodging tax apply to AB&B's. PERS related contributions are projected to be 30% of payroll by 2023. Economic development incentives may apply for electronic commerce.
- 6. Scott Whyte discussed an amendment to the Historic Preservation Code. Greg and Scot lead a discussion relative to the location of the new senior center. Carnegie location is not ideal, but it was hard to find an alternative.
- 7. Monte Wiens requested an update on improvements to Godsey Rd.
- 8. Meeting adjourned at 1:07PM.
